ALWAYS give you the link to the originating member. **Please reply using that link! DO**

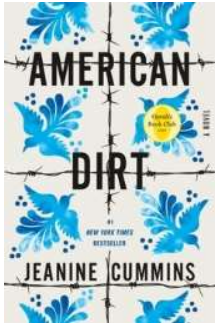
NOT HIT "REPLY!"

If you hit REPLY, the response goes to ME instead of the person who needs it, and if I miss that email, your response will not be counted!

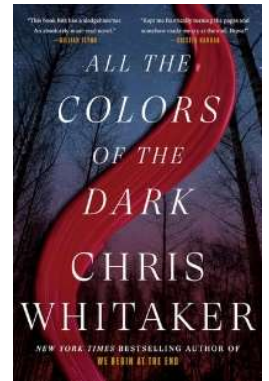
PcYc Book Club Selections for March and April
